Bradford (Park Avenue) AFC Club Code of Conducts

This document details that upon registering for BPA you understand the requirement to represent the Club to the highest standard, and that by breaking any part of this list of standards and expectations you understand this will result in sanctions that could lead to you being asked to leave the set-up.

BPA Players will:

- Uphold the highest standards of behaviour during training sessions and matches
- Uphold a welcoming football environment rooted in respect
- Respect their Coach and their teammates
- Respect the opposition players and opposition coaches
- Respect all match officials, without whom there is no game
- Be courteous and humble in victory and defeat
- Not use any foul or abusive language during training, matches, or around Horsfall Community Stadium
- Uphold the standards required when watching First Team matches
- Respect the equipment by helping the Coach collect equipment after each training session and take responsibility in helping keep the equipment safe
- Pay fines for any yellow/red cards promptly or they will not be allowed to play until doing so
- Accept that any sanction given by the Coach for breaking any of the above will lead to:
- 1. Missing a game
- 2. A week's suspension from training and games
- 3. De-registration and removal from the Junior Academy set-up

All BPA players have the right to:

- Be safe and happy
- Be listened to
- Be respected and treated fairly
- Privacy
- Enjoy football in a protective environment
- Be protected from abuse by others or outside sources
- Ask for help
- Have any concerns taken seriously and acted upon
- Use the Player Welfare page on 360Player to raise concerns to the Welfare Officers

BPA Parents will:

- Respect the coaches; match officials; other parents and spectators
- Help keep the environment safe for children by standing/sitting in the designated areas for training sessions
- Provide their children with the appropriate footwear/clothing including shin pads and a drink to training and matches
- Communicate with the Coaches through 360player and not on personal numbers unless necessary
- Take responsibility for ensuring payments are up to date

BPA Junior Academy Parents/Carers will not.

- Ridicule opponents for their mistakes
- Applaud foul play and will not incite our players to foul
- Use foul or abusive language to players, coaches, match officials or other spectators
- Enter the field of play during a game unless asked to do so by the referee
- Post derogatory or offensive comments regarding the Club and/or its members on social media

I understand that if I do not follow the code, I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents and / or issued a fine
- Obliged to undertake an FA education course
